Directions from the Westin Arlington Hotel to the Ballston-MU Metro Station

- Exit the hotel via the main entrance and follow the sidewalk to the right.
- Staying right, follow the access street to N. Fairfax Drive (Approximately one block).
- Turn right at N. Fairfax Drive and continue walking approximately two blocks to N. Taylor Street.
- Cross N. Taylor Street and continue walking along N. Fairfax Drive for another block to N. Stuart Street.
- Cross N. Stuart Street and the Metro Entrance is on your right hand side.
- Enter the Metro and take the Orange line train in the direction of New Carrollton.
- Exit the train at the Capitol South Metro Station.



Directions to the Thomas Jefferson Building of the Library of Congress from the Capitol South Metro Station

- At the top of the Metro escalators, turn left and walk up First Street towards C Street (If you are walking downhill, you are going the wrong way).
- Cross C Street and continue up the hill to Independence Ave.
- At Independence Ave cross First Street, then cross Independence Ave.
- The Thomas Jefferson Building of the Library of Congress is located on your right.
- Entry is from 7:30 a.m onwards, through the West Ground Level Entrance. This entrance is located up the first set of steps in the tunnel under the main entrance.

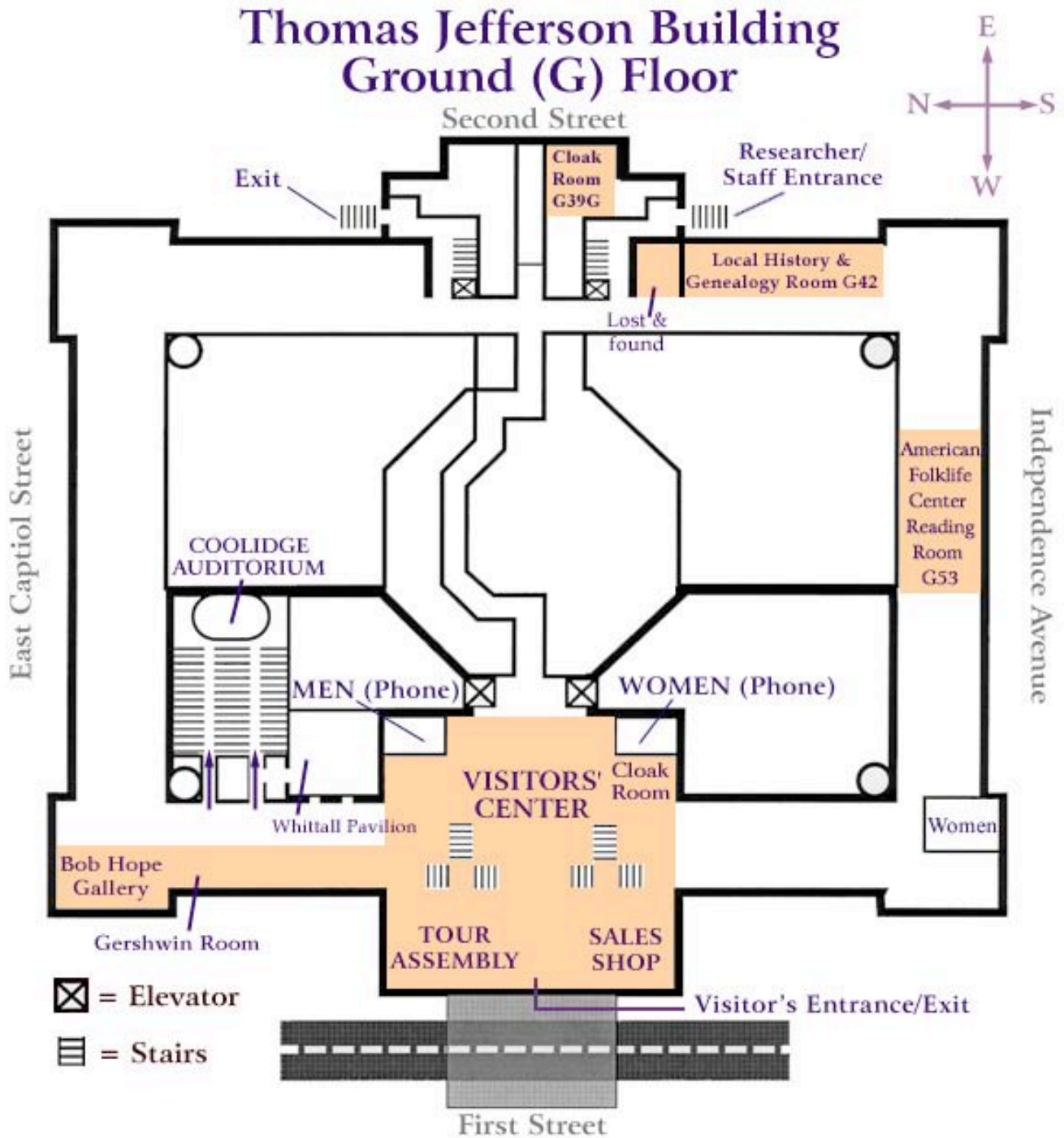
Directions from the Thomas Jefferson Building to the James Madison Building

- The entrance to the James Madison Building will be on your right side.



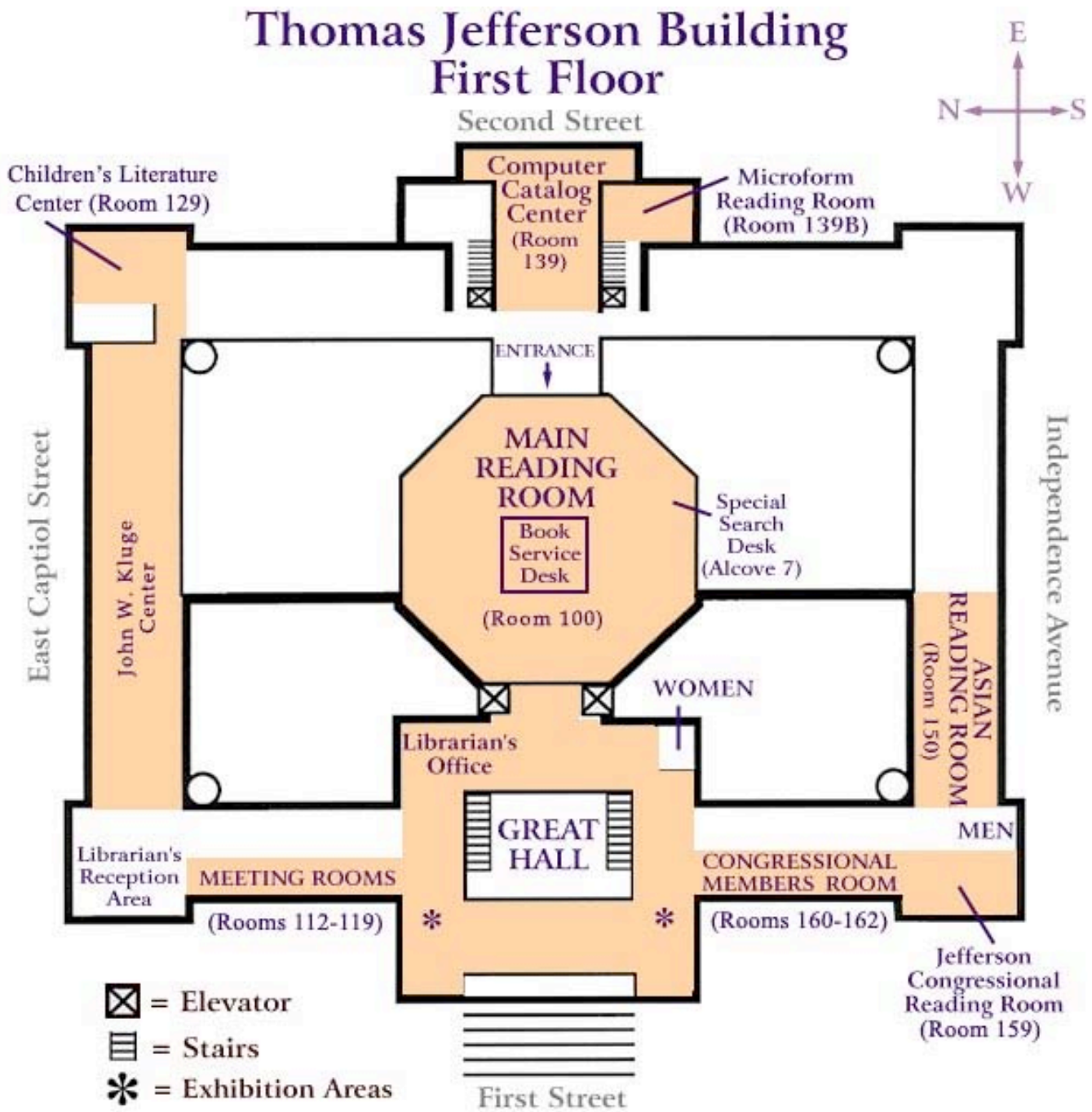
